ITEM 4 - DIVISIONAL REPORTS

Mr. Pat Polick, Interim Chief Inspector, presented the Quarterly Divisional Reports for December 2019 through February 2020. In addition, Mr. Polick provided, at the request of the Chair Mr. Hoveke, a year to year summary Division Report for comparison from March 2019 to February 2020, and for the prior year covering March 2018 to February 2019. 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- Title 32 IAC Part 505 – this item was briefly discussed by MR. Tom Andryk. Currently, IEMA is updating the relevant Codes and Standards. The process for updating their Codes and Standards started January 3 of this year and is currently in JCAR.
- Kensie Proctor has filled the office specialist position for the Boiler Division.
- One candidate has been selected to fill the position for a Boiler Safety Specialist in Cook County. The tentative start date is April 1, 2020. With this last position filled, Mr. Polick has all Boiler Safety Specialist positions now fully staffed covering the State regions.
- In addition to Kathy Dunlap and Kensie Proctor, the boiler division was approved for an additional Office Associate position.
- Mr. Thomas Runty was in attendance and member of the Illinois Historical Boiler Association. He mentioned that he is currently still involved with historical boilers and will be attending a meeting next week regarding piping, valves and fittings for historical boilers.
- Mr. Ed Hoveke, Chair of the Boiler Board had submitted his resignation to the office of Governor J.B. Pritzker effective June 1, 2020. Mr. Hoveke was presented with a plaque from the Boiler Board commemorating his time and contributions. Mr Hoveke mentioned it was a pleasure to serve on the Board and thanked all those who have helped make the Board a success. Pictures were taken and will be posted on the Boiler Division web site.
