The Board discussed about how new objects are captured and entered into the Boiler Safety Division database when industrial or apartment developments are completed. Chief Mike Vogel mentioned that his inspectors will take note of new buildings when making rounds and later inquire about the boiler system.

ITEM 5 – OLD BUSINESS

- New Inspectors for Boiler Safety Division begin March 18, 2019 for DeKalb and Lee counties. The Inspector for Cook County position is still vacant but will be re-posted.
- Two air dryer vessels which were submitted for state special application have been withdrawn by Solvay. The issue has been resolved for Solvay after traceability to the two vessels has now been restored and alterations can proceed under the NBIC.
- Status of the safety meeting was discussed. However, until the Assistant Boiler Chief position can be filled, the Safety meeting will be on hold.

ITEM 6 - NEW BUSINESS

- The Phillips 66 state special submittal for a reactor vessel was withdrawn by Phillips 66 as of this Boiler Board meeting. Phillips 66 formally decided to purchase a new ASME Code reactor vessel in lieu of pursuing the state special.
