The National Board Presented honorary memberships to several members, Robert Reetz, Kenneth Watson, Michael Verhagen & George Galanes. - The New NBIC 2017 code book will be released July 1, 2017 and become mandatory 1-1-18
- Mike Vogel discussed needed changes to Boiler Rules, we do not currently address LLC's & LLP's. Mike Vogel suggested we incorporate these entities into our rules by adding these entities on the application process. Mike is going to wait and see what the Secretary of State does on how they will address these issues. Mike Vogel will discuss with the board these proposed rule changes at the September's meeting.
