<u>ITEM 5 – OLD BUSINESS</u>

Tom Andryk informed the board that the new code updates rulemaking has been approved by JCAR on June 12, 2018. July 1st was the effective date for the revised rules which now includes the 2017 edition of ASME B&PV Code, 2017 NBIC and 2015 Edition of CSD-1.

ITEM 6 - NEW BUSINESS

- Mr. Dave Douin provided updates regarding activities associated with the National Board. The 100 year anniversary of the National Board will be held May 6 through May 10, 2019 during the General Meeting between ASME B&PV Code and the National Board in Salt Lake City, Utah.
- The 2019 Edition of the NBIC will be distributed to all participating Jurisdictions across the US after July 1st, 2019. The 2019 Edition of the ASME B&PV Code will be published in July, 2019 and become mandatory January 1, 2020.
- The National Board will be moving to all electronic filing of ASME data reports.
- New courses are being offered by the Training Department of the National Board. The courses will be complimentary to Jurisdictional Inspectors for training.
- Rules for Commissioned Inspectors will be published after January 1, 2019.
- October 3rd and 4th, 2018 is the Chiefs Technical Meeting at the National Board offices in Columbus, OH. Mr. Ryan Corn will be presenting on the Owner/User program.
