Purpose: This instruction provides for current policy and guidance to ensure uniform enforcement of 41 Il. Adm. Code 172.60(a).

Scope: Statewide

Current Code: Licensed contractors, their certified employees and non-certified workers working in a UST activity, and subcontract excavation operators (involved in UST related operations) shall possess, on UST jobsites at all times, 40-hour General Site Worker Program Identification Cards and any valid Refresher Cards that comply with OSHA standards. Cards shall be produced upon request by any OSFM representative. The card requirement is applicable only to UST installations, repairs, linings, removals, abandonments-in-place and physical interior inspections.

Policy Interpretation: Storage Tank Safety Specialist's will only be required to check for 8 hour refresher cards. After December 31, 2006, both the 8 hour and 40 hour OSHA cards will be required. If a person is unable to produce both cards after that date, that person will be required to leave the safety zone immediately.
