RE: AUTO-DIALERS

Please be advised that the Illinois Act listed below states that auto-dialers cannot be programmed to 911.

"(50 ILCS 750/15.2a) (from Ch. 134, par. 45.2a) Sec. 15.2a. The installation of or connection to a telephone company's network of any automatic alarm, automatic alerting device, or mechanical dialer that causes the number 9-1-1 to be dialed in order to directly access emergency services is prohibited in a 9-1-1 system. Violation of this Section is a Class A misdemeanor. A second or subsequent violation of this Section is a Class 4 felony."
