- 11) Changes made between the Proposed and Adopted Versions: In Subsection 100.3(g)(5) OSFM added a list of particular alternative codes which OSFM will consider as providing equivalent fire safety to this Part.

In Subsection 100.3(g)(6) OSFM added a list of means by which local jurisdictions subject to these rules may establish that different codes provide equivalent fire safety to

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this Part. OSFM also subsequently edited certain language in two provisions of this Subsection to read "in its entirety, is equivalent with this part when viewed holistically."

In Subsections 100.7(c)(12) and 100.7(c)(13) OSFM added clarifying language to the scope of regulations in the Subsection pertaining to requirements of (1) windows for rescue and (2) size and access to secondary means of escape in different sets of circumstances.

In Subsection 100.7(c)(5)(C) OSFM added clarifying language to make it clear that certain terms being used are defined in a particular code section (NFPA 101, Section 8.6.6).

In Subsection 100.7(c)(11) OSFM replaced the term "Natural Cut Christmas Trees" with "Combustible vegetation".

OSFM made other non-substantive grammatical and formatting changes.

- 13) Will this rulemaking replace an emergency rule currently in effect? No
- 14) Are there any rulemakings pending to this part? No
- 15) Summary and Purpose of Rulemaking: This rulemaking establishes the minimum life safety standards for the State for both new and existing occupancies.
