**Narrative Statement:**

The Kankakee County Emergency Telephone System Board was granted approval of an Emergency Telephone Number System for the County of Kankakee, IL on November 14, 1991; Docket No 91-0199.

The System currently consist of three (3) PSAP's; Kankakee County Consolidated Communication Center (KanComm), Bourbonnais, and Bradley. As per PA 99-0006 Kankakee County has a population of less than 250,000 with a single ETSB and more than 2 PSAPs therefore the number of PSAPs must be reduced by at least 50% or to two (2) PSAPs, whichever is greater. In February 2016 Bourbonnais announced it would be closing its dispatch center and relocating services to KanComm by December 31, 2016. This will leave Kankakee County with 2 PSAP's; complying with the Act.

Bradley will continue to be the backup PSAP to KanComm and KanComm will become the backup PSAP to Bradley. Bradley is a municipal PSAP dispatching for police, fire, and EMS within its village limits. All other public safety agencies within Kankakee County will now be dispatched from a single location; KanComm.

We will coordinate with our system provider, AT&T, the rerouting of ESN's 826 and 461 to KanComm.
