Narrative Statement:

The County of Whiteside established an Emergency Telephone System Board(ETSB), as authorized by Illinois Statute for the purpose of establishing and maintaining an Emergency Telephone Number System for the citizens of Whiteside County.

Pursuant to Public Act 99-006, (50 ILCS 750/15.4(a)(4)), In any county with a population of less than 250.000 that has a single Emergency Telephone System Board or qualified governmental entity and more that 2 PSAPs, the 9-1-1 Authority shall reduce the number of PSAPs by at least 50% or to 2 PSAPs, whichever is greater. On June 2, 2016, the Whiteside County ETSB voted to deactivate the Rock Falls PSAP on or before June 30, 2017.

The Rock Falls PSAP is a remote site with 2 answering positions connected to a Positron Viper System hosted at the Sterling Police Department PSAP.

There are 4 - 911 trunks that route the Sterling PSAP calls and 3 - 911 trunks that route the Rock Falls PSAP calls. All 7 trunks are terminated at the Sterling PSAP and the Viper routes incoming calls based on trunk line to the appropriate PSAP. There are redundant ALI circuits at the Sterling Viper. The Sterling PSAP is the back up PSAP to the Rock Falls PSAP. The Whiteside County Sheriff's Office PSAP is the back up to both the Sterling and Rock Falls PSAPs.

AT&T, the certified 9-1-1 system provider has completed a traffic study on all Whiteside County ETSB 9-1-1 members and determined that the existing trunk members in place are sufficient to provide p.01 grade of service for Sterling and Rock Falls.

The 2 Rock Falls positions will be relocated to the Sterling PSAP. All the positions at the Sterling PSAP will be configured to allow for the answering of all members. Tentatively, the following agencies will be contracting for dispatch services with the Sterling Police Department: Rock Falls Police & Fire, Sterling Fire and CGH Ambulance Service.

The Whiteside County Sheriff's Department PSAP will continue to be the backup PSAP to the Sterling PSAP and the Sterling PSAP will continue to be the backup to the Whiteside County Sheriff's Department PSAP.

ESN 123, in the AT&T Selective Router will be provisioned to the Sterling PSAP for Rock Falls Police, Rock Falls Fire and CGH Ambulance Services. This will be completed in conjunction with the deactivation of the Rock Falls PSAP.

On June 2, 2016, the Whiteside County ETSB approved this consolidation/modification plan.
