

The Illinois Torture Inquiry and Relief Commission (TIRC) is an independent state agency charged with investigating claims of torture resulting in a confession that was used to obtain the felony conviction of the claimant. If the Commission determines there is sufficient evidence of torture meriting judicial review, the claim is referred to court for further proceedings.

TIRC's FY2019 budget is \$417,900. It has one office at 100 W. Randolph St., Ste. 10-300, Chicago, IL 60601. It currently has three full time employees and is budgeted for a fourth.
