

IVHA Indoor Visitation Fact Sheet

- Please note that outdoor visits are strongly preferable to indoor visits, weather permitting.
- Visits will be conducted in 45-minute increments with a total of 6 time slots available:

9:00 am – 9:45 am, 10:00 am – 10:45 am, 1:00 pm – 1:45 pm, 2:00 – 2:45 pm, 3:30 pm – 4:15 pm, and 7:00 pm – 7:45 pm

- Visitors must schedule an appointment with the facility to visit a resident.
- All visitors will receive a pre-screening call prior to their visit.
- All visitors must be screened with temperature and symptom check before entering the unit.
- All visitors must perform hand hygiene with alcohol-based hand sanitizer as they enter the unit.
- Visitors must wear a facemask at all times. If you do not have one, one will be provided.
- Visitors are restricted to the room where visitation will occur and must remain distanced from other visitors or residents in the area.
- Visits may occur in the small Activity Room.
- Visits may occur in the resident room if private.
- If the resident is fully vaccinated, they may choose to have close personal contact, but PPE must remain in place. Hand hygiene is also required before and after the contact.
- Staff will provide intermittent supervision and reserve the right to end the visit if proper guidelines not being followed.
- Visitors must immediately notify the facility if they develop symptoms of COVID-19 within 3 days after visiting.
