

IVHQ Indoor Visitation Fact Sheet

- Please note that outdoor visits are strongly preferable to indoor visits, weather permitting.
- Visits will be conducted in 30-minute increments.
- Visitors must schedule an appointment with the facility to visit a resident. This can be done via calling the unit's social worker.
- All visitors will receive a pre-screening call prior to their visit.
- All visitors must have a rapid antigen COVID test before entering the unit. This will be free of charge and performed by the unit before entering. Please report 15 minutes early to your visit to allow for testing and screening before entering.
- All visitors must be screened with a temperature symptom check before entering the unit.
- All visitors must perform hand hygiene with alcohol-based hand sanitizer as they enter the unit.
- Visitors must wear a face mask at all times while on the unit. If you do not have one, one will be provided.
- Visitors are restricted to the room where visitation will occur and must remain distanced from other visitors or residents in the area by at least 6 feet(?). Visits may occur in the resident room if private.
- If the resident is fully vaccinated, they may choose to have close personal contact but must continue to wear a face mask. Hand hygiene is also required before and after the contact.
- Staff will provide intermittent supervision and reserve the right to end the visit if proper guidelines not being followed.
- Visitors must immediately notify the facility if they develop symptoms of COVID-19 within 3 days after visiting.
